### **Qualitative feedback**

Thanks to those five who supplied written comments (in accordance with our policy I have deleted them from this document). The comments were generally favourable (3 out of 5 were unqualified compliments). One student stated a preference for more seminar readings upon 'philosophical systems that require a lot of knowledge' (his/her example is consequentialism). I will consider this for next year, but it is important that the seminar topics reflect the range of topics covered by the module and the exam (and resit exam). It would be possible to devote the bulk of the module to a more in-depth treatment of, say, consequentialism vs deontology in normative ethics. But I don't think this reduction of range would be very popular. It is worth pointing out also that there were suggestions for further reading (over and above the required seminar readings) in the weekly summaries on VITAL. One student suggested the seminars could be structured more analytically to indicate how the topics might be related to questions that come up in the exam. This might be difficult to do in any very precise way without giving away what is in the exam! Otherwise I think the seminar discussions (including in those groups taught by Juan, rather than me) did all revolve around issues related to potential exam questions, although their precise structure was of course determined by the content of the presentations.
